

From New York State

Even if you are near Buffalo or Niagara Falls it is quicker and cheaper for you to drive through NY to Syracuse and take I-81 straight north through Watertown and then across the border. Before you reach the border I-81 becomes Highway 191. When you cross the border into Ontario the road becomes highway 137.

Just after crossing the border take highway 137 to Highway 401. Go west on Highway 401 for 19 miles to Highway 38 – Also called Road 38. Take Road 38 32 miles north to Sharbot Lake. Drive through Sharbot Lake to Highway 7. Road 38 ends at Highways 7. Turn left on highway 7 and drive about 1.5 miles to Road 509 to Clarendon.

Turn right on Road 509 and drive about 5 miles to Ardoch Road. Turn left on Ardoch Road and drive 3 miles to Lodge Road. Turn right on Lodge Road and follow to camp.
